Any Appeal must be lodged with the appropriate Regional Official, or in the case of the Scottish Junior Cup, with the SJFA Secretary, within 2 working days of the game (no later than 5.00pm) accompanied by relevant documentation and video evidence.

Appeal fee of £25 will become payable should the appeal be dismissed.

An appeal is not competent unless the player who committed the offence is identified.

A panel of 3 members selected from the SJFA Management Committee will view / consider the evidence and establish a determination.

The Match Official's report should be accessed via the Club Admin System.

Appellant must email the SJFA Secretary by 5pm on Working Day 2 with all evidence and submissions. This must include video evidence to allow appeal to proceed. **N.B.** This submission plus video evidence only will form the basis of the appeal.

The SJFA Secretary will acknowledge receipt of the appellant's evidence and submissions and confirm when the appeal will be heard. This will be as soon as practically possible after 5pm on Working Day 2.

The Hearing to Determine the Appeal will take place by conference call. The expectation is that the Hearing will commence on Working Day 3 if possible. The appellant is not required to attend or make representation at the hearing.

The Appellant will be advised of the outcome / determination.

Please note that there is no right of appeal to these proceedings.
